When: Saturday May 9 10 AM



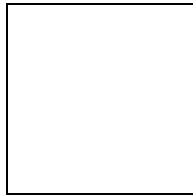
To You and Yours

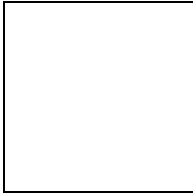
