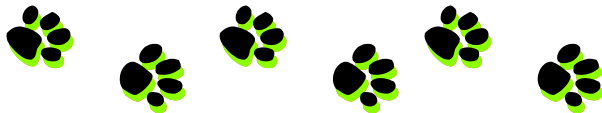

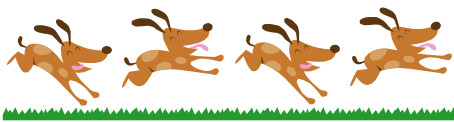

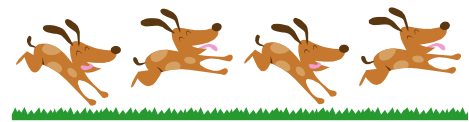
I thought this was a vacation???

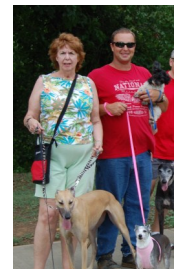


CONGRATS!

So, welcome Jeebers, may you be loved and cared for by your people and greyhound brothers, and may you live a long and healthy life in your new forever home!

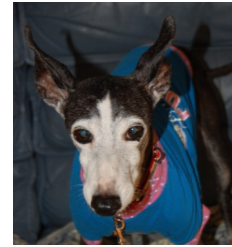
Looking for Their Forever Homes...

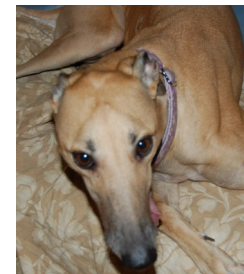

WARNING! Hot weather alert!

Be very careful with the hot temperatures that you and your hounds are ok. Take walks in the early morning or at night after the sun goes down. Never take your animals in the car during the hot months unless you have to. They can die in as little as 10 minutes in a hot vehicle. Also check the pavement when you are walking your dogs on hot days. The pavement can burn their paws. Put your hand on the pavement and if you have to move it then it is too hot for your dog to walk on. If you have to take your dogs in the car, make sure you bring water for them. If you see an animal in vehicle contact your local animal control department or local law enforcement office.
