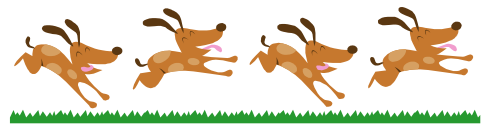
Tractor Supply Day

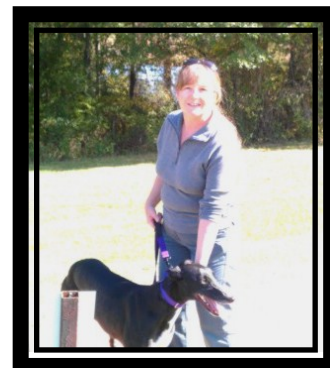


CONGRATS!

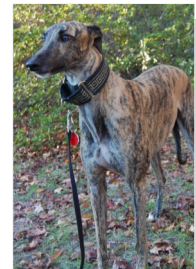
Harley: He is a black and white boy who was born in 1999. He is very cute with the big ears and friendly personality. He is special needs because of his age.

Manney: He is a beautiful blue brindle who came in with an open wound and bad bruise on his back leg. X-rays revealed he had a previous injury that broke his



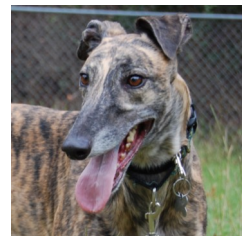
