big ears and seems alert all the time.

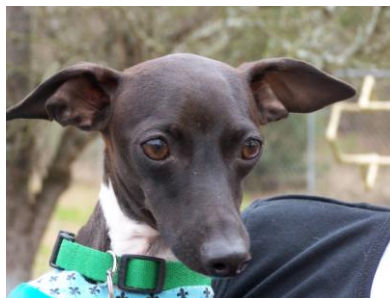
Athena: Born in 2003, she is a brindle lady with an elegant roman nose. She is very lovable and especially loves cuddling. Definitely a dog that will love you back.

As greyhound owners go, Susan Waldo is our senior tender. That is, she tends to want to rescue and care for dogs that have gotten up a bit in years. There is a very special place for people like Susan. And greyhounds who

have found her are blessed to have done so!

Susan resides in Warner Robins with her husband, Michael and daughter Briana.

Their home is filled with greyhounds! Namely: **Bomber**, a 13 year old male blond fawn who answers to the name Big Beautiful Boy Bomber; **Flicker**, 12, a blue/brindle aka Flickerice; **Sinai**, 11 a red-fawn female known as Sweets; **Whipper**, 7, red-fawn male aka Pretty Boy Floyd or Whip Dip; and **Connie**, 5, a red brindle known as Kisses.

All of these hounds have been arriving at the Waldo home since 2002 and have come via Greyhounds Galore.

Besides the hounds, they also have a beagle/dachshund they rescued from the pound 11 years ago; 4 guinea pigs, 1 rabbit and 1 military macaw.

When asked to comment on owning greyhounds, Susan replied "Greyhounds are an addictive breed. They are very intelligent. When they first come into your home, a

couple of no's will do but not too many. It is like they have been in your home since puppyhood and they know what they should do and not do. Our hounds are very routine oriented. They never miss a walk (2 a day) no matter how cold it is or how hard the rain is coming down. We figure it s the least we can do since they were not sure if they could ever trust another human. We do not own our hounds; our hounds own us. They own our hearts."
