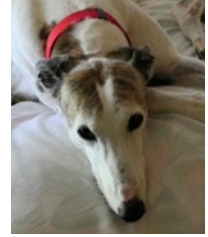

The New Queen of the House



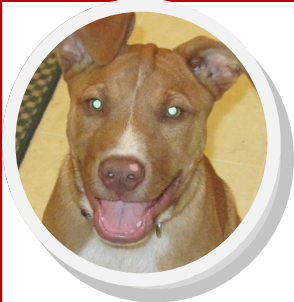

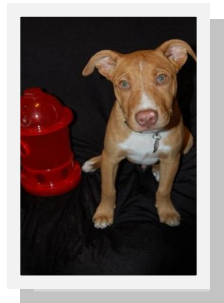

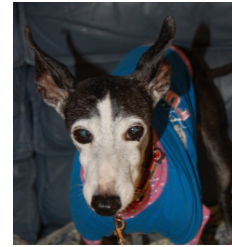
Looking for Their Forever Homes...

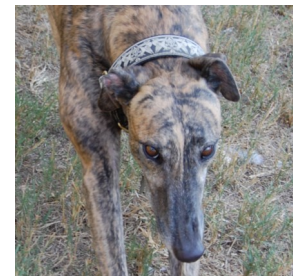

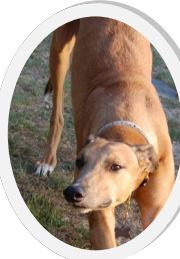
